Re: NWBSA Travel Teams Equipment

The equipment for HOME games at Wilde Memorial, Faber and the High School this season will reside in bins located behind my garage at 57 Stonefield Road (north off Harristown Rd east of RR tracks – 9th house on left, a beige ranch). There may be a gold dog roaming the yard that makes some noise, but he is essentially a coward and if you are not wearing a U.S. Postal Employee uniform he won't have any issues with you. Goals: inspect the goals at the field to confirm that they are suitably anchored with stakes or counterweighted with at least two sand bags on the lower cross bar. Do not allow anyone to climb on or hang from the goal frame or nets. *Please report any issues or damage to the goals or nets to me.*

Corner Flags: a coach from the first game scheduled at each field each day will need to pick up a set of 4 flags from my house. If there is a later game scheduled at that field the late game coach is responsible for returning the flags to the bin. It is important that the flags be returned by day's end as they are needed for other games each weekend.

Game ball: the HOME team is responsible for providing a properly inflated game ball acceptable to the referee. Each team will receive two new game balls (size 4 for Div 4 and size 5 for Divs 2 & 3). Please try to ration the game balls to get through the season on a couple. There will be a bin with new inflated GRSC Balls, both size 4 and size 5, if needed. There will be a hand air pump available; please leave / return that to the bin.

Pinnies: when there is a team jersey color conflict (think Allendale, Fair Lawn, Maywood) it is the HOME team that must supply and don pinnies. Each team was distributed pinnies for scrimmage/practice. You can use those for color conflict games, or there is a bin of bagged pinnies marked "Game 12" with enough for a full team. Please return those to the bin after each use.

First Aid Kits: Each team should already have a stocked kit, let me know if you do not. There are bins available with latex gloves, water for rinsing cuts & abrasions, gauze, bandages, tape, antibiotic ointment, ace bandages and 2 sizes of cold compresses. Feel free to take whatever you need to keep your kit stocked.

Practice balls: Each team should already have a bag of at least 9 practice balls. Please let me know if you need additional balls.
